What is Payroll Giving?

Payroll Giving is an easy and tax efficient way to support us. Every donation is deducted from your income before you pay the tax, so for standard rate tax payers the charity receives £1.00 for every 80p donated or £1.00 for every 60p donated from higher rate tax payers.
